1. Registration will take place inside the drivers lounge in Garage #2 (middle).**NOTE** <u>All drivers must have wristband credentials to get on the track</u>. HPDE drivers will have two wristbands, one for the general waiver and another for your specific HPDE group. HPDE group wristbands will be given out in HPDE meetings. Race group will only have one wristband. Check schedule for meeting times.

I) Friday – This event does not have any Friday track activity.

II) Saturday/Sunday- Follow the instructions below.

- 1) Annual Inspection- You are required to have a 2016 Annual inspection prior to your first race of the season. Cars without a NASA logbook will require a \$40.00 fee for new logbook and inspection. Cars with a NASA logbook will require a \$20.00 for an annual inspection renewal.
- 2) Racers must sign the general waiver and <u>wear a wristband at all times</u>. You may obtain this from Registration on Saturday morning. Please obtain this prior to going to pregrid.

HPDE

a) "Preteched"- <u>Any repair shop with an ASE certified mechanic may perform your</u> <u>inspection.</u> 1) Bring tech form (that has been signed by a tech shop) to tech trailer and exchange for a tech sticker. 2) Apply tech sticker to upper left corner of windshield. 3) Attend HPDE drivers meeting at time specified on schedule

b) "Trackside Tech"- <u>HPDE Trackside Tech fee is \$5.00</u> 1) Bring your car to impound for inspection by 7:30 AM. 2) Car will be inspected, tech form will be signed and you will be given a tech sticker. 3) Attend HPDE drivers meeting at time specified on schedule. 4) Make sure your tech sticker is on your car when you line up in pregrid.

2. Drivers Meetings- Check Schedule on Reg Page.

a) Race- All drivers must report to the drivers meeting at the specified time and roll will be taken.

b) HPDE- Report to the drivers meeting at time indicated on schedule and you will be assigned to a run group leader and wristbands will be distributed.

3. Transponders- (Transponders not used in HPDE 1&2)

We are using the AMB timing system and time all groups except Gp1/2. A transponder is required for race and TT groups. If you have your own transponder, you should have entered the number when you registered. If you did not fill this number out please email me the number. If you need to rent a transponder, please go back to the event registration page and rent one online.

4. Tech Inspection

a) Race- All cars must have a log book. Please make sure your vehicle has a valid Annual. We ask you to be prepared for an Annual Inspection and this is the worksheet you may use to help determine your car will pass inspection.

5. Reminder- All race cars are required to have a side impact net or a seat with head bolsters on the right side. Please see CCR 15.17.9 All racers are required to use a SFI 38.1 approved Head and Neck Restraint (CCR 15.17.8)

6. Schedule

Please check event registration page for weekend schedule. *Please note that schedule may not be posted until a few days before the event when higher capacity is evaluated.*

7. Chapel Service

8. Announcements

9. Arrival, Parking, Gate Fee, RV info

There is no admission charge for Auto Club Speedway. You may arrive at 3PM on Friday and you must vacate the track by 8PM Sunday. Camping is allowed but no water or sewer hookups are provided. You may only park in the garage area if you have an assigned garage space. Otherwise, park/paddock in the RV lot closest to the infield.

10. Paddock Maps and Traffic Flow

All drivers will be required to follow the one way directions to enter and exit the track. DO NOT DRIVE THROUGH CONES OR BARRICADES. Speed limit is 5MPH in the paddock. Anyone caught speeding will be penalized

11. Other Important Stuff

A) Fuel pumps are operated by the track and they sell 112 & 98, and 91 octane

B) Tire service will only provide mounting and balancing services for this event.

C) Food Service will be available at the track.

D) DO NOT leave or dump oil at the track. Anyone caught will be permanently suspended E) Do not litter. Leave your pit space clean or be charged \$100.00

F) Motorized Scooters are prohibited. It is an insurance regulation and we apologize for the inconvenience. However, any "licensed" driver may operate vehicle that can be licensed to use on the road (moped, bicycle, ATV).
